Free Shuttles to the Party of the Century

Free shuttles courtesy of SuperShuttle will be running continuously from 4 to 11pm with stops at McCambridge Park Recreation Center (Glenoaks Boulevard and Amherst Drive) and the Downtown Burbank Metrolink Station (201 N Front Street).

Opening Ceremony

5pm - Festivities begin with the National Anthem sung by Ashley Aparicio and live broadcast in front of City Hall (275 E Olive Avenue) featuring NBC4 Weatherman Fritz Coleman, civic dignitaries, former Mayors and celebrities from Burbank's rich film and television production history.

Cupcake Extravaganza

Air Parade

5:45pm - The celebration takes flight with an awe-inspiring air parade paying honor to Bob Hope Airport, Lockheed and Burbank's close ties to aviation. You won't want to miss this historic flyover including U.S. Navy F/A-18 Hornets, B-25 Mitchell bombers, Burbank Police Notar helicopters, helicopters from Los Angeles County Sheriff "Air 5" Rescue, Los Angeles County Fire and the Orange County Sheriff departments and Aero Squadron World War II planes. *Sponsored by the Bob Hope Airport.*

Mascot Parade

Cartoon characters and popular mascots will parade from City Hall to San Fernando Blvd where there will be numerous photo ops. Led by Bugs Bunny, the parade includes Burbank High's Bulldog, John Burroughs Cheer Squad, Hootie the Owl, Domino's Noid, Geoffrey the Giraffe, the H.T. Bee, McGruff the Crime Dog, Burbank Fire Department's L'il Squirt and many more.
