The youth sports program provides various instructional camps, sports leagues, and special programs throughout the year. Recreational competition is provided for both boys and girls. Teams are coached by volunteers who share their time and talent with the participants.

## YOUTH TEAM REGISTRATION

Youth sports league registration is accepted on a “team basis.” Individual players’ names will be added to a Free Agent List. Players’ names are distributed to existing teams expressing an interest in adding new players or to new teams that are forming. For those players not contacted and placed on a team, their parents are required to attend a parent’s meeting. The purpose of these meetings is to recruit new coaches. Staff will make every attempt to recruit coaches for these players, however there is no guarantee of placement on a team. *Earn \$14 - \$15 per game!*

The Youth Officials Program is available to youth in 8th grade and above. Youth Officials are used to officiate youth baseball (February), softball (February), and basketball (September/October).

# ADULT SPORTS

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The adult sports program offers men and women an opportunity to participate in organized leagues in a recreational setting. Registration is accepted on a "team basis" only. Individuals may put themselves on a player referral list but there is no guarantee of team placement. Divisional classifications range from top-flight play to low-level recreational leagues in a variety of sports. The adult program offers play in basketball, roller hockey, slow-pitch and fast-pitch softball, and volleyball.

## REGISTRATION

All teams may register on-line ([www.burbankparks.com](http://www.burbankparks.com)) beginning the first day of registration or in person during normal business hours at the Sports Office.

All teams may register during the two week registration period. At the time of registration, you will be asked if you are a \*resident or non-resident team. Teams registering as resident will be assessed with the resident fee. Teams registering non-resident will be assessed an additional \$25 fees. *\*Resident teams are required to provide residency verification.*

Any team which fails to submit the completed Roster and Assumption of Risk paperwork (and residency verification) by the stated paperwork deadline will be removed from the league and all league fees less \$50 will be returned.

## FEES

Resident fee applies to teams in which 75% of their players either live or work in Burbank. All corporate teams must maintain 66% of players working for one company. Non-resident fee applies to all others. Officials fees are per game, per team. Softballs provided.

## SPORTS OFFICIALS' TRAINING
