PRESENTATION

a. HOLLYWOOD BURBANK AIRPORT STUDENT ART "TOWER BANNER"

CONTEST - PRESENTATION OF THE WINNING ENTRIES – No staff report is attached. For the past 12 years, the Authority has supported the high school art programs at each school district of Burbank, Glendale and Pasadena. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners from each school district will present their winning composition to the Commission based on this year's theme "Heroes of Aviation."

7. ITEM FOR COMMISSION APPROVAL

- a. AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR LANDSIDE PAVING REHABILITATION PROJECT NUMBER E18-17. A staff report is included in the agenda packet. At the April 1, 2019, Operations and Development Committee meeting, the Committee voted unanimously (3–0) to recommend that the Commission: (i) authorize an Award of Contract for Landside Paving Rehabilitation in the amount of \$157,400 to PALP, Inc., dba Excel Paving Company; (ii) authorize a project budget for construction management, administration and quality assurance testing services for a not-to-exceed amount of \$20,000; and (iii) authorize a project aggregate contingency in the amount of \$17,000 for unforeseen circumstances that may arise during the course of construction.
- b. AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT UNIVERSAL PROTECTION SERVICE LP DBA ALLIED UNIVERSAL FOR ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC CONTROL SERVICES. A staff report is included in the agenda packet. Subject to the recommendation from the Operations and Development Committee at its meeting immediately preceding the Commission meeting, Staff seeks approval from the Commission of proposed Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment") to the Professional Services Agreement ("Agreement"), copy attached, with Universal Protection Service LP, dba Allied Universal, to provide

additional traffic control services specifically to coordinate the Transportation Network Company activities at the Airport. The proposed Amendment is for a term of 18 months beginning May 1, 2019, to coincide with the original three-year term of the Agreement for an amount not-to-exceed \$220,500.

- a. FEBRUARY 2019 PARKING REVENUE STATISTICS. No staff report attached. Staff will present parking revenue data for the month of February 2019.
- b. FEBRUARY 2019 TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES. No staff report attached. Staff will update the Commission on TNC activity for the month of February 2019.
- c. FEBRUARY 2019 PASSENGER/CARGO AND REGIONAL AIRPORT PASSENGER STATISTICS. A staff report is included in the agenda packet. Due to severe weather conditions experienced in the Pacific Northwest and the Northern California Bay area, the month of February had multiple flight cancellations. These cancellations impacted the February 2019 passenger count of 368,039, which was a relatively flat 1.04% increase compared to the previous year's count of 364,245 passengers. Air carrier aircraft operations increased by 3.65% with cargo volume decreasing in February by 2.93% for a total volume carried of 7.87 million pounds.
- d. AIRLINE SCHEDULE ANALYSIS. A staff report is included in the agenda packet. The Airlines serving Hollywood Burbank Airport have notified Staff of changes in service, fleet mix, and scheduled operating times. This report reflects the changes in detail on the attached Schedule Change Analysis.

At the Planning Board meeting of April 8, 2019, the Planning Board met for a public hearing to discuss the following items:

Public Hearing

1. Project No. 17-0002839 | Conditional Use Permit and Development Review | 115 S. Victory Blvd.

The Board was presented an item requesting to construct a 1,013 square foot carwash exclusively operated by Enterprise Rent-A-Car to wash the vehicles assocated with the company's existing renal facility at 110 S. Victory Blvd. The Board conditioned the operational hours of the carwash to be open from 8:30 am - 6:00 pm on the weekdays and 9:00 am - 4:00 pm on the weekends. In addition, the Board recommended adjusting the traffic route that leads to the car wash, per the discretionary approval of the City Traffic Engineer. The Board approved the project by a 4-0 vote.

2. Project No. 18-0002676 | Planned Development No. 2001-2 | Development Agreement Extension | 3201 W. Olive Ave. – Bob Hope Center

The Board was presented with an extension request for a current Development Agreement (DA) at the Bob Hope Office Center until December 31, 2020 to allow for the completion of the Environmental Impact Report (EIR). The Board approved the extension by a 4-0 vote.
