

OCCUPANCY STANDARDS

Occupancy standards serve to prevent the over or underutilization of units that can result in an inefficient use of housing assistance. Occupancy standards also ensure that tenants are treated fairly and consistently and receive adequate housing space.

The Housing Authority counts the number of persons in your family when determining unit size. The Housing Authority does not make distinctions based on sex and age of family members, nor the relationship of persons in the family. The Housing Authority applies this same criteria and standard to all families.

The Burbank Housing Authority has set the following Occupancy Standards for family and unit size:

Bedroom size	Maximum number of people
1	4
2	6
3	8
4	10
