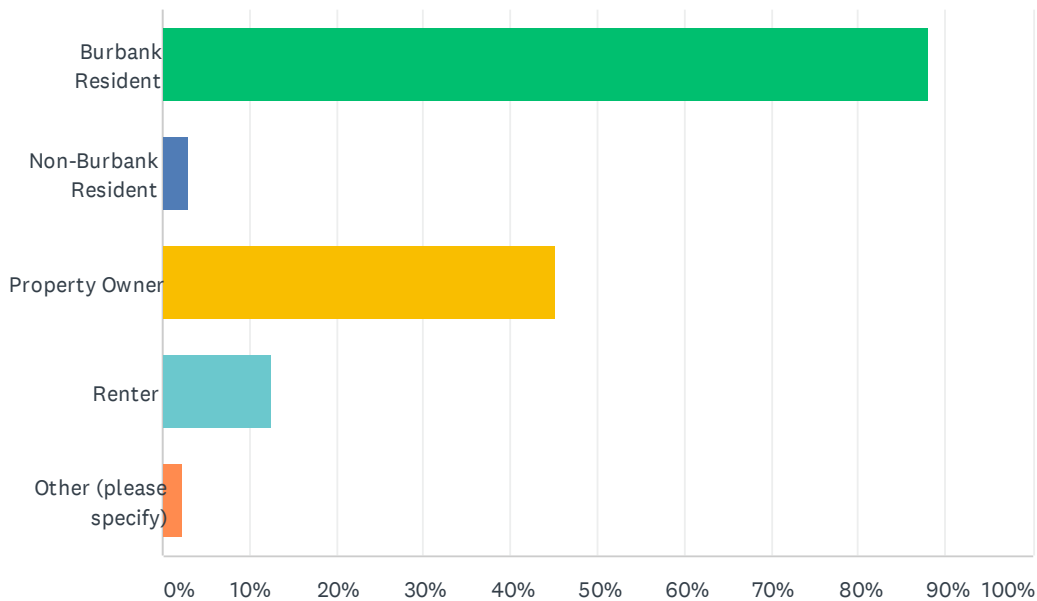


## Q1 What best describes you? Select all that apply.

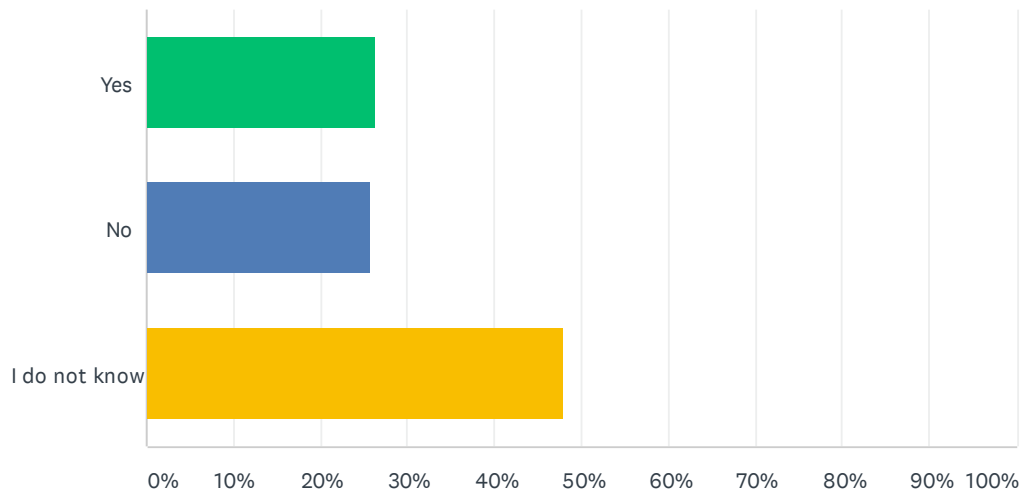

## Q2 Do you live near a short-term rental?

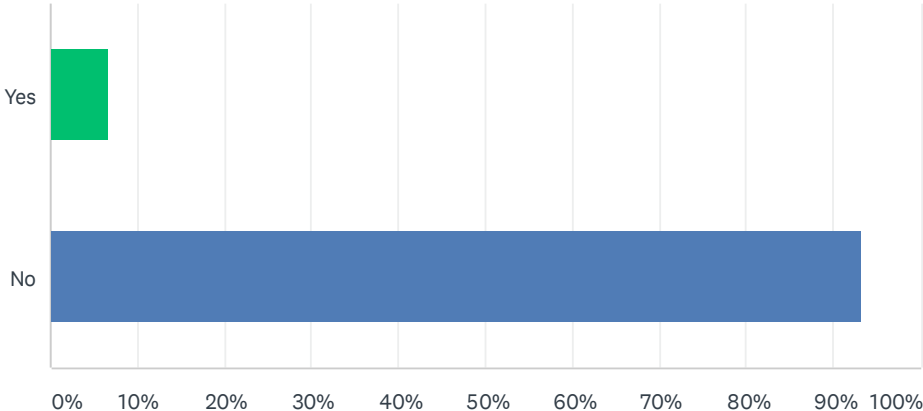

### Q3 Do you operate a short-term rental in Burbank?

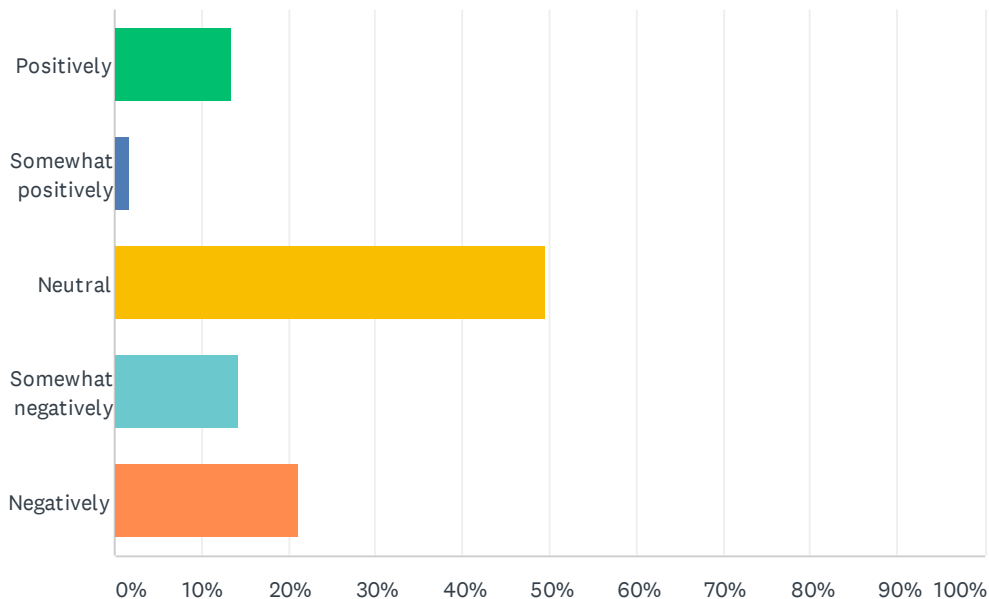

## Q4 In Burbank, how has short-term rental impacted you and your family?

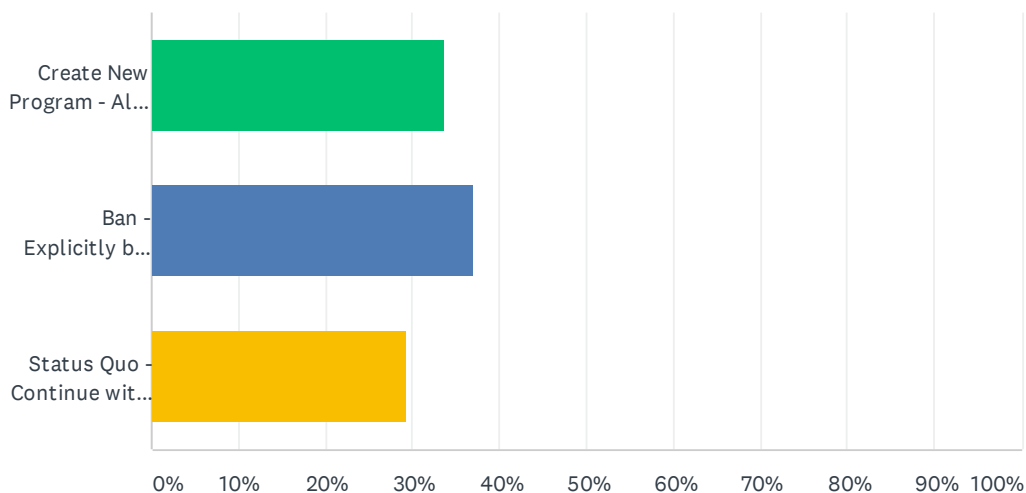

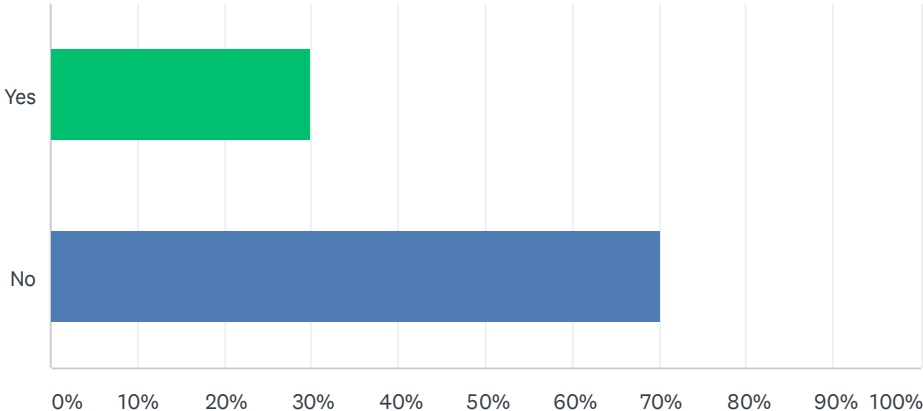

### Q6 Are short-term rentals an issue in your neighborhood?

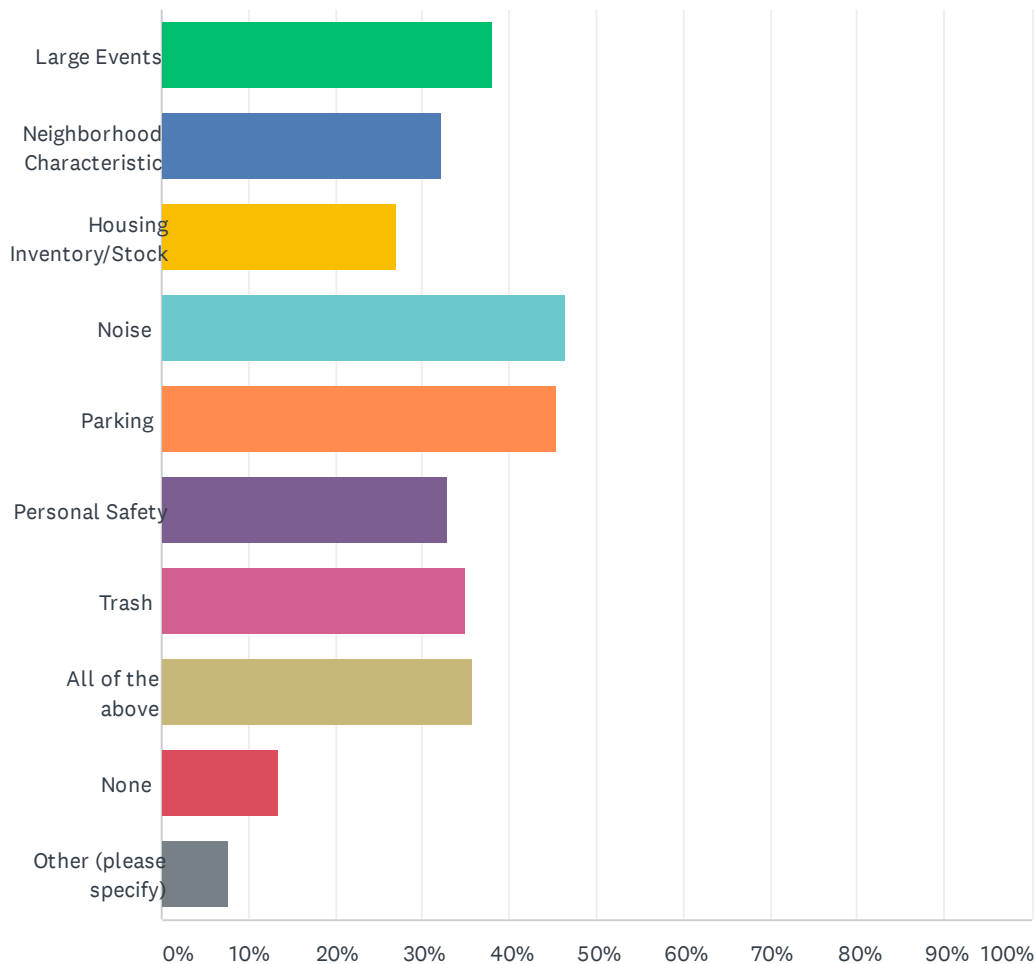

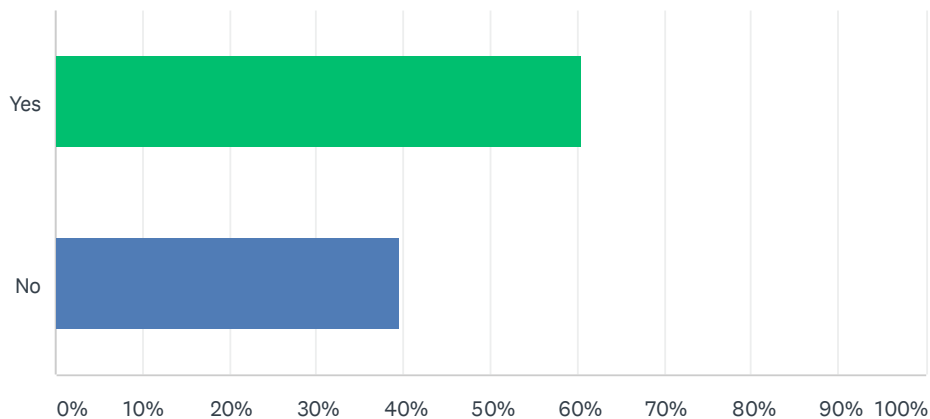

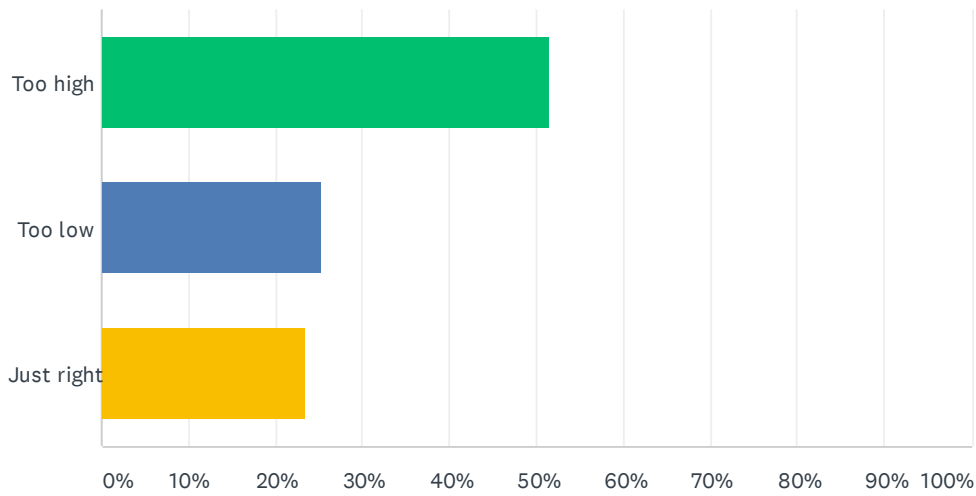

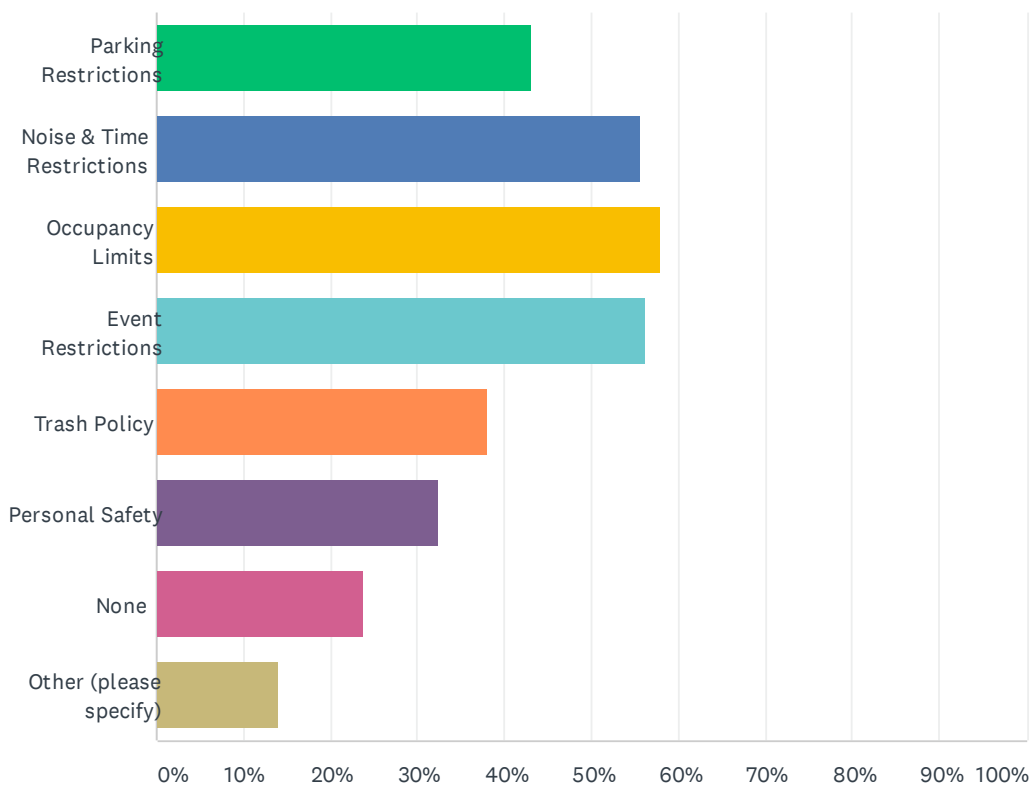
