I served on the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Water District from 1992 -2004. During my tenure I was a lead negotiator in discussions on Colorado River water transfers from Imperial Irrigation District to the San Diego County Water Authority and in negotiations to prevent proposed water extraction from the aquifer underlying the Mojave. During my tenure MWD engaged in extensive efforts to harden the regional water supply against future droughts - this included conservation programs and development of the Diamond Valley Reservoir. Throughout my tenure on the board there was a consistent effort to manage ongoing demand, anticipate and plan for long range supply needs, while maintaining and improving infrastructure all within budget.

My interest is working to maintain Burbank's "first in class" standing among municipal water and power agencies by continuing to focus on reliability of services and the cutting edge environmental leadership of projects like the utility's eco-campus.
