## **Post Vaccination Instructions**

- If you are having an emergency call 911 and seek immediate medical attention
- The CDC encourages you to sign up for the V safe program, vaccine surveillance. Information is available with this packet.

- You will be provided with an email about 1 week prior to your vaccination appointment, you will need to preregister by following the guidelines in that email. If you have questions, contact your department scheduler. The email will come from your employer.
- It is likely that your second dose appointment will be at a different, local venue. Please pay attention to those details when you receive your next appointment invitation.
- If you cannot make your second appointment, contact your scheduler
- The goal is to receive the second vaccination as close to 28 days as possible. It is okay if this date is up to 42 days after the first injection. - You need to keep your white vaccination card and <u>bring it with you to your second</u>
  <u>vaccination appointment</u>. We cannot replace your card, however electronic
  documentation can be provided as proof of vaccination at a later date, if needed.
