Why are you interested in serving on a board, commission or committee?

I am a nearly 20 year resident of Burbank and live near the airport on Kenwood Street. My spouse of nearly 22 years, Terri Segura-Coomes, moved with her family to Burbank at the age of 2 in 1972, and her parents still reside in the same house on Harvard just above Kenneth. We bought our home in 2001 just before the birth of our daughter. Terri and I are raising two children now ages 19 and 16 who have grown up in the Park and Recreation's Tiny Tots program at McCambridge Recreation Center, attended Ralph Waldo Emerson Elementary School and Luther Burbank Middle School. My spouse attended St. Roberts Elementary and Bellarmine Jefferson High School, and she wanted at least a piece of a parochial school experience for our children. With the closure of Bell-Jeff, our children have attended and are at St .Genevieve High School. Both of our children grew up in the Burbank sports leagues (where my spouse, her siblings and I have played softball for the last 25 years) and I took my experience as a youth softball and baseball coach to be the head softball coach at St. Genevieve for the past 5 seasons. At one point in time both of my parents and my grandmother lived in Burbank and benefitted from the community they

found at Tuttle Senior Center. My grandmother celebrated her 100th birthday with this community of friends. Burbank is most definitely our home and I hope to be able to contribute to this community to help others experience the sense of home that I continue to enjoy. I have both professional and personal experience that I believe would directly benefit the Police Commission, the City Council, the Burbank Police Department and our community. I am a social worker by training and have been employed by and served Los Angeles County for the past 25 years. I have held a number of positions, starting in child protective services and then working for the Department of Mental Health for the past 22 years. For the past 13 years, I have been the program manager at the Olive View Community Mental Health Urgent Care Center, where we provide crisis mental health services to the community and to those experiencing homelessness. I have been a licensed clinical social worker since 2002 and have been involved in direct service delivery, administrative services, program development, management and crisis intervention. Much of my work has involved helping people understand the importance of mental health care and helping people navigate these systems when they need it most. This past year has been particularly difficult for all of us. The pandemic and social unrest tied to both political and racial identity issues has highlighted tensions. I have gained experience in my professional life and my church community to talk about these issues directly and to seek solutions while establishing and deepening meaningful relationships with others. Current and prior professional experience has placed me adjacent to law enforcement entities for the purpose of policy development, collaboration and conflict resolution. While I identify as a person of color, it is not enough, and having experience with providing and helping others access mental health care is not the complete solution, but applying these experiences to build trusting relationships based on open communication has led to building healthier communities. I would very much like to offer my experience to my home community that has already given so much to my own family. Having participated in multiple annual homeless counts in Burbank I am acutely aware of the increase in the number of people experiencing homelessness and have firsthand experience addressing the intersection between mental health needs and homelessness. Personally, I identify as African American and am part of a multiracial family. From my own experience overseas in middle school, in Irvine for high school, and into adulthood, I have experienced both positive and negative interactions with law enforcement that have influenced my educational and professional path. This past year has been particularly moving for me. After the 1992 civil unrest while I was in college, I had the opportunity to work with the Los Angeles County Bar Association's Dispute Resolution Services, Inc. in the development and implementation of a community mediation process called Neighbor to Neighbor. Mediation, conflict resolution and crisis negotiations have been consistent tools in my professional career as I have worked with community members in crisis and the systems, including law enforcement, with whom they have come in contact. In 2020, former County Supervisor Mark Ridley-Thomas instructed all County Departments to initiate an anti-racism, anti-oppression process to open communication, identify systemic racism and other barriers to equity and inclusion, and propose solutions to ensure equity, diversity and inclusion. I became involved in that process within the Department of Mental Health and currently serve on the Department's inaugural Anti-Racism, Diversity and Inclusion (ARDI) Staff Advisory Council. In addition to my conflict resolution and mental health experience, I bring this insight to the table, which is central to many discussions and challenges across the country involving law enforcement systems. I believe that our communities become stronger and more resilient through collaboration and civic involvement. Committee and commission work is central to my spiritual identity. We develop and implement better, more meaningful and lasting solutions when we do this in collaboration with and in relationship with each other.

Education

After earning a bachelor's degree in sociology at UCLA, I stayed and earned a master's degree in social welfare where I specialized in child protective services. Following college, I completed the requirements and examination to become a licensed clinical social worker. I complete 36 hours of continuing education every two years to maintain the clinical license. Those trainings include classes in law and ethics, clinical supervision, and current best practices in mental health treatment.

I remain actively involved in mental health service delivery in an educational setting as an adjunct faculty member of the UCLA Semel Institute for Neuroscience and Human Behavior where we train psychiatry residents, nurse practitioner students and social work interns. This setting regularly brings me in contact with various law enforcement entities who have detained individuals exhibiting mental health symptoms and who are seeking alternative interventions to the criminal justice system. I often find myself explaining the extent and limitations of the mental health service delivery system based on the presentation and will of the individual, applicable law and available resources. On a personal level, I have had the honor of advising and mentoring a number of youth and young adults who oversee a nonprofit organization called The ChangeWorks! Foundation. This foundation grew out of overwhelming Burbank community support for a young adult and his family who were battling childhood cancer in 2014. Through this organization, involvement with scouting and through coaching, I appreciate having the opportunity to mentor and support youth who are envisioning what the future holds for them.

We can and should have community discussions regarding how we can better serve people who interact with our police force, people such as crime victims, domestic violence survivors, and our teen community. We need to make sure that far right groups who bring threats and fear to Burbank are neutralized and residents are reassured of their safety. We must as a community address how hate exists in Burbank as we have seen neighbors become victims of hate crime. When an event galvanizes the nation, such as the murder of George Floyd, we should have those in Burbank who can proceed to lead community discussions so that we grow together and learn together. Building community trust should be paramount at this time. In order to build that trust, now is the time to ensure that the protection of public safety coincides with the protection of civil rights and human rights. I am ready and willing to work to make sure that trust exists now and in the years to come.

I was one of three mothers who led the successful campaign to switch from glyphosate (RoundUp) to non-toxic weed abatement in our parks and schools. I was actively involved in the Measure I campaign and the renaming of Huerta Middle School, and volunteered for several county and statewide ballot measures as well. I have also actively participated in Commission meetings for the past year, as well as general Council and Burbank Unified meetings for even longer. So I understand how residents can engage and effectively make change in Burbank. Professionally, I have worked in mission-driven non-profit organizations for almost my entire adult life. I have 10 years of professional experience in community safety data research and analysis throughout California. I would love to bring that experience to the Commission. Schools, houses of worship, community centers, and key local businesses are all good places to start. I would love to see the Police Commission hold dialogues in those types of places to meet people where they are, especially as the timing and location of Commission meetings may not work for all residents. The recent virtual townhall conducted by the Burbank Human Relations Council on policing was a good starting point. I will also push the department to share the reasons behind their policies and any data that can be made public to increase transparency and trust. I am a minority (Armenian) woman who has spent a majority of my childhood and life in Burbank and attended a local Burbank elementary/middle school. My husband and I purchased our Burbank home in 2012 and since then, we have both been heavily involved in our community - whether it be in our local schools or our local AYSO Board. Burbank has a large Armenian community that is historically a minority group with unique interests that should be addressed - at the very least by representation on this important commission. As a member of a minority community, I am uniquely situated to see and understand those impressions and relationships with our local police department. Additionally, as a woman and a mother of young but growing children, I am also attuned to the issues that face our youth as it relates to BPD. Lastly, I have extensive background, training in, and knowledge of law enforcement practices, the realities of the functioning of a law enforcement agency, and the importance of accountability. I currently represent police officers who are sued for constitutional rights violations. However, I am also a former criminal prosecutor and previously also represented public entities (e.g. cities and counties) who investigated law enforcement officers for criminal acts and administrative policy violations.
