**EXTENDED NOMINATION PERIOD FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020
CITY OF BURBANK GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

BURBANK, CA. (August 7, 2020) – The nomination period for the November 3, 2020 City of Burbank (City) General Municipal Election which opened July 13, 2020, and closed August 7, 2020, for two (2) City Council seats for full four-year terms ending on December 16, 2024 and one (1) City Treasurer seat for an unexpired term ending December 19, 2022 has been extended through **Wednesday, August 12, 2020, at 5:00 p.m.** Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10225, if Nomination Papers for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by or on the 88th day before the election, during normal business hours, as posted, the voters shall have until the 83rd day before the election during normal business hours, as posted, to nominate candidates other than the person who was the incumbent on the 88th day, for that incumbent's elective office. The incumbent who did not file Nomination Papers is as follows:
