RISE is a **free** eight-week program designed to inspire leadership, empower, and foster constructive dialogue to invigorate civic engagement. This grassroots program will broaden your understanding of the City and its resources. RISE will connect you to City of Burbank officials, as well as local non-profits and businesses. Apply to join us for a behind-the-scenes look at effective leadership in action and what it takes to operate a full-service City.

Applications will be accepted from adults 18 years or older, including youth in their senior year of high school, who are committed to creating a positive change in the community through service and empowerment. Program sessions will be held every Wednesday from 5:30 to 7:30 pm, from September to October 2021, with the exception of one Saturday Session tentatively scheduled for October 16, 2021. The program will conclude with a graduation ceremony on Saturday, October 30, 2021. A detailed schedule of class sessions will be provided upon selection.



Participants are required to be Burbank residents.
