PROJECT: The Actors' Gang "Shakespeare-in-the-Park: Two Gentlebots of Verona" touring performances for families in Burbank.

Bairton Warburton-Brown (Multi-Disciplinary) Burbank, CA | \$1,500 grant award

PROJECT: The 2nd Annual "Afrofuturist Art Fair," a free, public, multimedia exhibition showcases local authors, designers, and performers from underserved communities.

Burbank Community Band (Music), Burbank, CA | \$3,000 grant award
