

RESOLUTION NO. 26-29,727

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURBANK, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES ORDER THE CONSOLIDATION OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES THE SAME DAY INCLUDING CHARTER AMENDMENT AND ORDINANCE FOR BY-DISTRICT COUNCIL ELECTIONS MEASURES; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CANVASS THE RETURNS OF SAID GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION; AND TO REQUEST THAT THE REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK OF SAID COUNTY BE PERMITTED TO RENDER FULL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF BURBANK RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF SAID GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE SECTIONS 10403 AND 10418

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURBANK FINDS:

A. The Council of the City of Burbank (Council) has called a general municipal election for November 3, 2026 (see Resolution No. 26-29,707) and desires to place two measures on that ballot: 1) a Charter Amendment Measure that, if adopted, would remove the requirement for at-large elections of City Council members and permit the City's electoral system to be specified by ordinance (Charter Amendment Measure, see Resolution No. 26-29,725) and an Ordinance Measure that, if adopted, would change the City's electoral system from at-large to by-district Council elections with respect to electing City Council Members, establishing district boundaries by adopting Map 130, and scheduling elections within the districts (By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure, see Resolution No. 26-29,726).

B. Council also passed Resolution No. 26-29,708 requesting that the proposed November 3, 2026 General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election in the County of Los Angeles to be held on the same date, pursuant to the authority found in California Elections Code Section 10403; and that within the City the precincts, vote centers, and election officers of the elections be the same, and the County Elections Department of the County of Los Angeles canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

C. Council further desires that the Charter Amendment Measure proposed in Resolution No. 26-29,725 and the By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure proposed in Resolution No. 26-29,726 be included on the consolidated election ballot.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURBANK RESOLVES:

1. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10403, the Board of Supervisors is hereby respectfully requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of said General Municipal Election including the Charter Amendment Measure proposed in Resolution No. 26-29,725 with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of voting on the measure.

2. The Charter Amendment Measure shall appear on the ballot as follows:

3. The By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure shall appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the Ordinance be adopted adding Chapter 3 to Title 2 of the Municipal Code changing the City's electoral system for City Council elections from at-large to by-district elections in the districts reflected in Map 130? Supporters: _____ Opponents: _____	Yes	No

4. The Council recognizes that the Consolidated Municipal Election will be conducted in the manner prescribed by Elections Code Section 10418. The County Elections Department is hereby authorized and respectfully requested to canvass the returns of said General Municipal Election including the Charter Amendment Measure and By-District Council Elections Ordinance Measure that each require a majority of the votes cast to pass. The Consolidated General Municipal Election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

5. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue any necessary instruction to the County Elections Department to take all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election requested in this Resolution and the City Clerk, as the City of Burbank Elections Official, is authorized and directed to work with the County Elections Department as necessary and appropriate.

6. The Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and respectfully requested to authorize and permit the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los

Angeles to:

a) Print and supply ballots for said City of Burbank General Municipal Election including the Charter Amendment Measure and the By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure;

b) Mail the City of Burbank General Municipal Election's sample ballots including the Charter Amendment Measure and the By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure to the electors of the City of Burbank as part of the same material that will be mailed to the voters of the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles; and,

c) Perform such other services as may be required for the consolidation and conduct of said City of Burbank General Municipal Election including the Charter Amendment Measure and the By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure with said Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles.

7. The election precincts, vote centers, hours of voting, and officers of election for said County of Los Angeles conducted statewide election, as established, designated and named by the Board of Supervisors for said statewide election, and as set forth in any notice pertaining to said County conducted statewide election, which has been or will be published by the County of Los Angeles, are hereby established, designated and named, respectively, as the election precincts, vote centers, hours of voting, and officers of election for this Consolidated Municipal Election. Only one ballot, namely the ballot used at said County conducted statewide election, shall be used for this General Municipal Election including the Charter Amendment Measure and the By-district Council Elections Ordinance Measure, and such election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

8. The vote centers for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 4005 and 14401.

9. The City of Burbank recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.

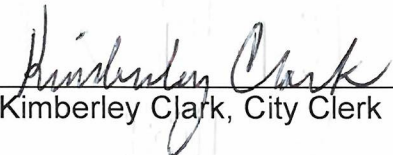

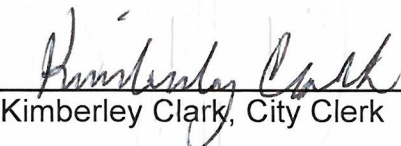
