I have lived in Burbank, built a career in Southern California, and I am raising my family here. I would like to put my experience to work for the city, not just benefit from it. My background is operational and public-spirited: I served as a U.S. Army logistics officer and Captain across two combat tours — a 15-month tour in Iraq and a 12-month tour in Afghanistan; I advised the Mayor of Sacramento on innovation and economic development; and I have run multi-site operations across Southern California — including HVAC, plumbing, and electrical field services businesses that serve Burbank — and now operate a custom manufacturing business. Each taught the same lesson: the infrastructure underneath an organization — how it is planned, funded, and maintained — decides whether everything built on top of it holds. Burbank is well run, and I want to help keep it that way by bringing a disciplined, numbers first approach to how the city plans and spends.

I am in the process of acquiring Superior Awning, a custom awning and shade-structure manufacturer based in Panorama City. I am not aware of any current contract between the company and the City of Burbank, but a manufacturer of this type could conceivably bid on or supply City projects in the future. I also hold a meaningful amount of stock in Metropolis Technologies, Inc. — one of the largest parking operators in the United States — acquired as an early employee of the company. Metropolis or its subsidiaries may operate parking on behalf of the City or at nearby City-owned assets, though I am not aware of any specific relationship. Because this board makes recommendations on parking, I am noting it here. I also own my home in Burbank, at 1631 N. Maple Street. I would disclose all three interests fully on my Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) and would recuse myself from any matter before the board in which Superior Awning, Metropolis Technologies, or my property had a financial interest.

My experience maps onto this board's core work — the high-level review of scope, schedule, cost, and risk on infrastructure projects, and the adequacy of maintenance programs — and includes time inside city government. As a Harvard Business School fellow in the Office of the Mayor of Sacramento, I co-founded the Mayor's Office of Innovation and shaped the policy for an \$8 million city fund, so I understand how a municipality plans and funds initiatives. As a U.S. Army logistics officer and Captain, I led a 30-person team sustaining a 5,000-person brigade across 22 bases — directing maintenance for 1,000 vehicles, 22 fuel points, and facilities under hard constraints. I have since run HVAC, plumbing, and electrical field services operations — the building systems at the center of a city's programmatic capital and maintenance — and stood up a manufacturing facility end to end, from capital equipment to vendor onboarding. My Harvard M.B.A. and ownership of multi-site P&Ls anchor the budget and risk side. I am not a licensed engineer; my value to this board is the management, oversight, and finance lens its establishing ordinance asks the Council to seek.

What are your goals in serving on this Board/Commission/Committee?

To help the city get full value from every infrastructure dollar. Concretely: hold the annual capital and maintenance prioritization to a clear scope-cost-risk standard; make sure routine maintenance is not deferred into far larger future bills; check that funded projects deliver what was promised, on the schedule and budget set; and help explain to residents, plainly, why maintaining the city's assets matters. I would bring rigor and follow-through, and decisions made in the city's interest — not a personal agenda.

This committee's work is grant administration — reviewing funding applications, analyzing performance, and ensuring federal compliance — and I have done closely related work inside city government. As a Harvard Business School Service Leadership Fellow in the Office of the Mayor of Sacramento, I co-founded the Mayor's Office of Innovation and created the policy for an \$8 million city fund that made grants to educators and equity investments in startups. I know what a credible funding proposal looks like, how to judge one on merit, and how to hold recipients to measurable results. Through volunteering on Habitat for Humanity home builds, I have also seen up close the kind of community work these federal dollars support. My Harvard M.B.A. and experience running businesses keep me fluent in budgets and outcomes, and as a combat veteran I bring a perspective the committee's own appointment criteria specifically call for.

To make sure Burbank's limited federal dollars go to the highest-impact uses, and that the organizations receiving them are held to measurable results. I would focus on rigor in the review — clear criteria, honest performance assessment, and careful stewardship of public money.

My experience is not with Burbank infrastructure specifically, but it is closely related. I have worked inside city government — as a Harvard Business School fellow in the Office of the Mayor of Sacramento, where I co-founded an innovation office and shaped the policy for an \$8 million city fund — so I understand how a city plans, funds, and prioritizes. As a U.S. Army logistics officer and Captain, I led a 30-person team sustaining a 5,000-person brigade across 22 bases, directing maintenance operations for 1,000 vehicles, 22 fuel points, and supporting facilities. I have run HVAC, plumbing, and electrical field-services operations — direct, daily exposure to the building systems and maintenance cycles that make up much of a city's programmatic capital. And as the operator of a manufacturing business, I own the full cycle this board reviews: major capital projects; routine and programmatic capital — the recurring maintenance and replacement that keeps a facility running; and the annual call on how to prioritize limited funds, then checking the next year what was accomplished against what was planned. The scale and the public-funding rules differ; the discipline — scope, schedule, cost, risk, and honest after-the-fact review — does not.

As someone who contributes to Burbank's infrastructure tax pool, and hopes to inherit the debts and progress of my city in the future, I hope to help advise council to spend our infrastrcutre dollars in a disciplined and reserved way. Over the last few years, it's become clear Burbank cannot rely on the support of governments above us to fund our infrastructure ambitions; Burbank will need to be more disciplined in the way we go about spending our Measure P dollars. Our Measure P dollars will have to support our infrastructure ambitions more independently. I would advise council to encourage more private-public partnership developments to the effect of growing our city in a financially disciplined way, in an ever more stringent funding environment. Anywhere we can apply the Central library's P3 model we should. Burbank will need to build now, and fast, while we can, to keep the benefit of funding we're awarded from the federal government before we lose access to the ever-fleeting dollars from above. I would recommend city council to build now, while we can - and spend what we can to maintain the infrastructure Burbank already has as opposed to new projects that may not be disciplined and receptive to the concerns of a worried taxpayer.
