The deadline to submit an application to the Burbank City Clerk's Office is Friday, October 2, 2026 by 5:00 p.m. The appointments are tentatively scheduled to be made at the October 13, 2026, City Council Meeting. All City Board, Commission, and Committee members serve without compensation from the City. No individual shall serve on more than one Board, Commission, or Committee at the same time. Any person appointed to fill a vacancy shall hold office for the remainder of the unexpired term. Persons appointed to serve unexpired terms must complete the term before applying to serve on another board, commission, or committee. All applicants must reside within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Burbank (per BMC §§ 2-1-404, 2-1-405, 2-1-406, and 2-1-407).

Burbank Cultural Arts Commission Information

The Burbank Cultural Arts Commission shall make policy and funding recommendations on matters related to the implementation of the City's Cultural Arts Plan, help engage the community by participating in various public education, outreach, and promotional activities related to cultural arts and other duties as requested by Council. The Burbank Cultural Arts Commission shall have the duties to: act in an advisory capacity to the City Council in establishing policy on all matters as described; engage the participation of the community; provide community support for advancing policy initiatives and programs; advise the City Council in the maximizing and leveraging efficient use of resources in the community; advise the City Council in the review of proposals, programs, practices, and goals; other duties as requested by Council.
