Burbank City Councilmember Nikki Perez has been our champion and friend at city hall.

She has fought for renters struggling to remain in their homes, helped secure millions of dollars for homeless services, expanded support for local nonprofits, invested in Burbank's firefighters and emergency response teams, and she was recently appointed to the California Film Commission where she's working to increase entertainment jobs that support thousands of local households.

Nikki Perez is a renter, a working mother, and a lifelong Burbank resident raising her family in the same community that raised her. She understands the pressure of rising rent, childcare, grocery bills, and job uncertainty because her family lives those pressures every day.

Nikki Perez is running for re-election to continue her work on establishing rent control, create incentives that make childcare more affordable, expand park access and community programs, and continue funding local organizations through the Burbank Community Grant Program.

Nikki Perez will keep Burbank's emergency services exceptional, ensure Burbank Water and Power and Forestry emergency response teams have the staffing they need, protect immigrant residents from the use of local resources for federal immigration enforcement, and continue to defend the dignity and rights of transgender and LGBTQ+ residents.
