A City Council Public Hearing to Consider a Request to Designate the House Located at 1515 E Alameda Avenue, as a Historic Resource

What is this?

This notice is to let you know that the City Council of the City of Burbank will be holding a public hearing to consider a request to designate the house at 1515 E. Alameda Avenue as a historic resource. The subject house is a one-story 1,348-square-foot, Craftsman style, single-family residence constructed in 1923. The Heritage Commission held a public meeting on September 4, 2025, and voted 4-0 to recommend that the City Council designate the house and detached garage as a Historic Resource. The proposed designation has been evaluated under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and is exempt from further CEQA review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15308, Class 8 pertaining to Actions by Regulatory Agencies for the Protection of the Environment and there are no unusual circumstances that would preclude the use of this exemption. Additionally, the documents and other materials that constitute the record of proceedings related to the designation, upon which the decision to recommend approval of the proposed Resolution, qualifies for a commonsense exemption under CEQA or in the alternative, is not a “project” subject to CEQA review, and therefore requires no further evaluation.
