Final Statement on the Use of Funds
Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026

The purpose of this notice is to provide citizens with a description of the activities the City of Burbank proposes to undertake during FY 2025-2026 by City Departments, nonprofit subrecipients and contractors. These activities are funded using the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development CDBG Program. On June 10, 2025, the Burbank City Council allocated \$1,072,998 in CDBG funds for the following projects and programs.

1. <i>Burbank Temporary Aid Center – 1304 W. Burbank Blvd., Burbank, CA 91506</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized for emergency assistance and services for the homeless, those at-risk of homelessness, and for low to moderate-income persons.	\$45,000.00
2. <i>Family Service Agency of Burbank – 2721 W. Burbank Blvd, Burbank, CA 91505</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized for multidisciplinary, therapeutically supported care for participants of Family Service Agency’s long-term transitional housing programs.	\$30,000.00
3. <i>Burbank Noon Lions – City-wide program</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized to provide eye/ear testing, eyeglasses, and hearing aids to special need populations and children who are low-income and uninsured.	\$1,600.00
4. <i>Home Again Los Angeles – 2406 N. Naomi St., Unit A, Burbank, CA 91504</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized to provide homeless outreach services dedicated to Burbank families who are unsheltered.	\$48,000.00
5. <i>Armenian Relief Society – 517 W. Glenoaks Blvd, Glendale, CA 91202</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized for social services aimed toward promoting self-sufficiency for low to moderate-income adults living in Burbank.	\$13,000.00
6. <i>Boys and Girls Club of Burbank – 300 E. Angeleno Avenue, Burbank, CA 91502</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized to provide afterschool and summer camp programs for children enrolled in local schools or from low-income households between the ages of 5 – 18 years.	\$20,000.00
7. <i>Fine Arts Revolution – City-wide program</i> Eligible Activity: Limited Clientele Activities [24 CFR 570.208(a)(2)] Description: CDBG funds will be utilized to provide creative wellness programs and services to homeless individuals.	\$3,349.70
