- What is the phone number you are calling from?

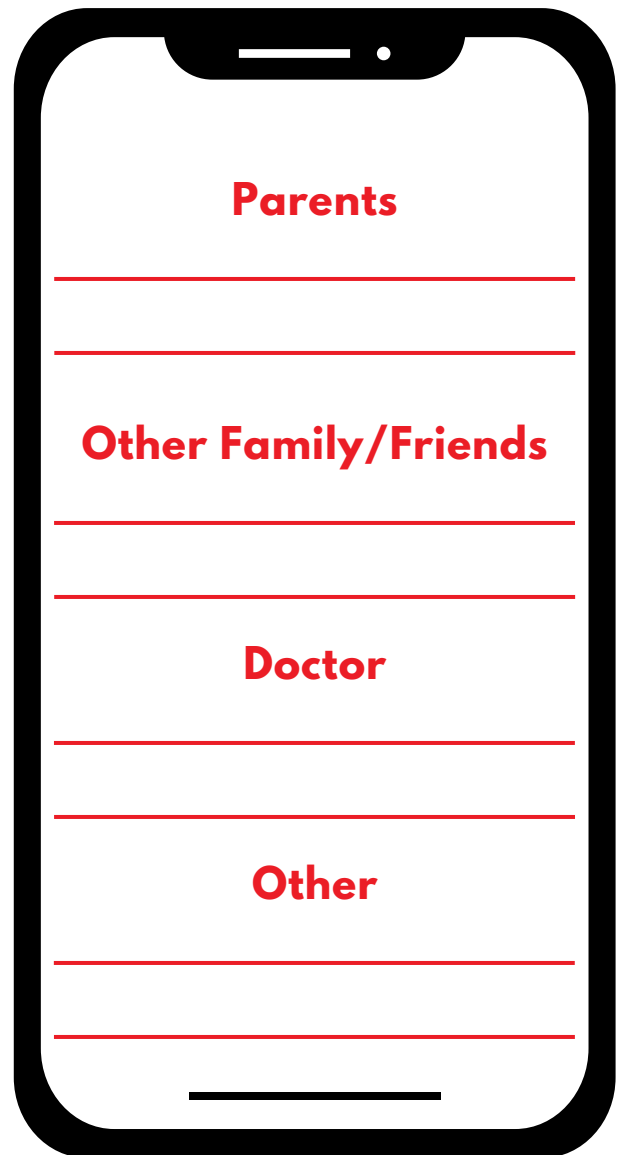

Keep Smoke Alarms Working Right

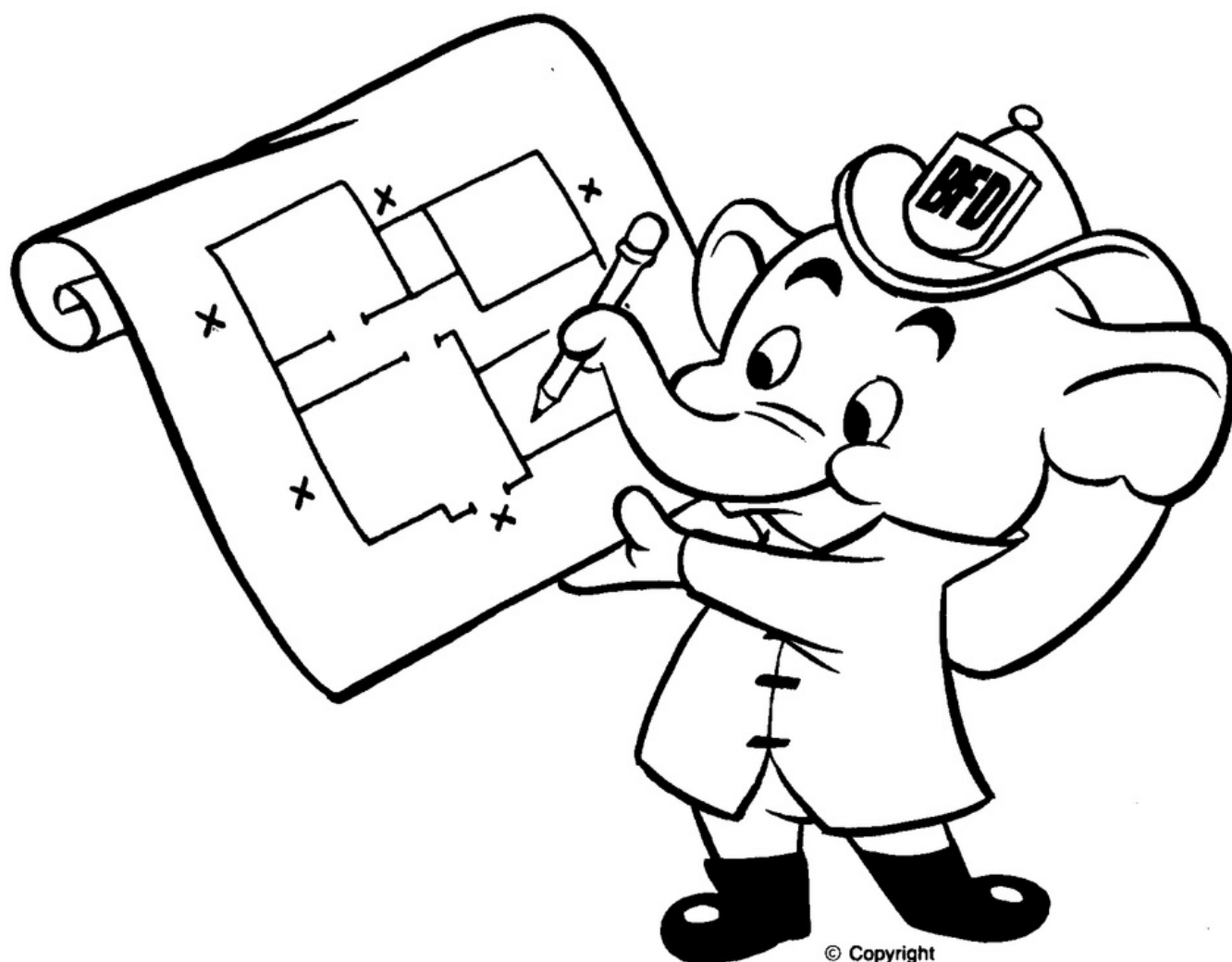
Smoke alarms make loud noises so people know when to get out fast in case of a fire. Install a smoke alarm on every floor of your home, and in or near every bedroom.

Test smoke alarms every month!

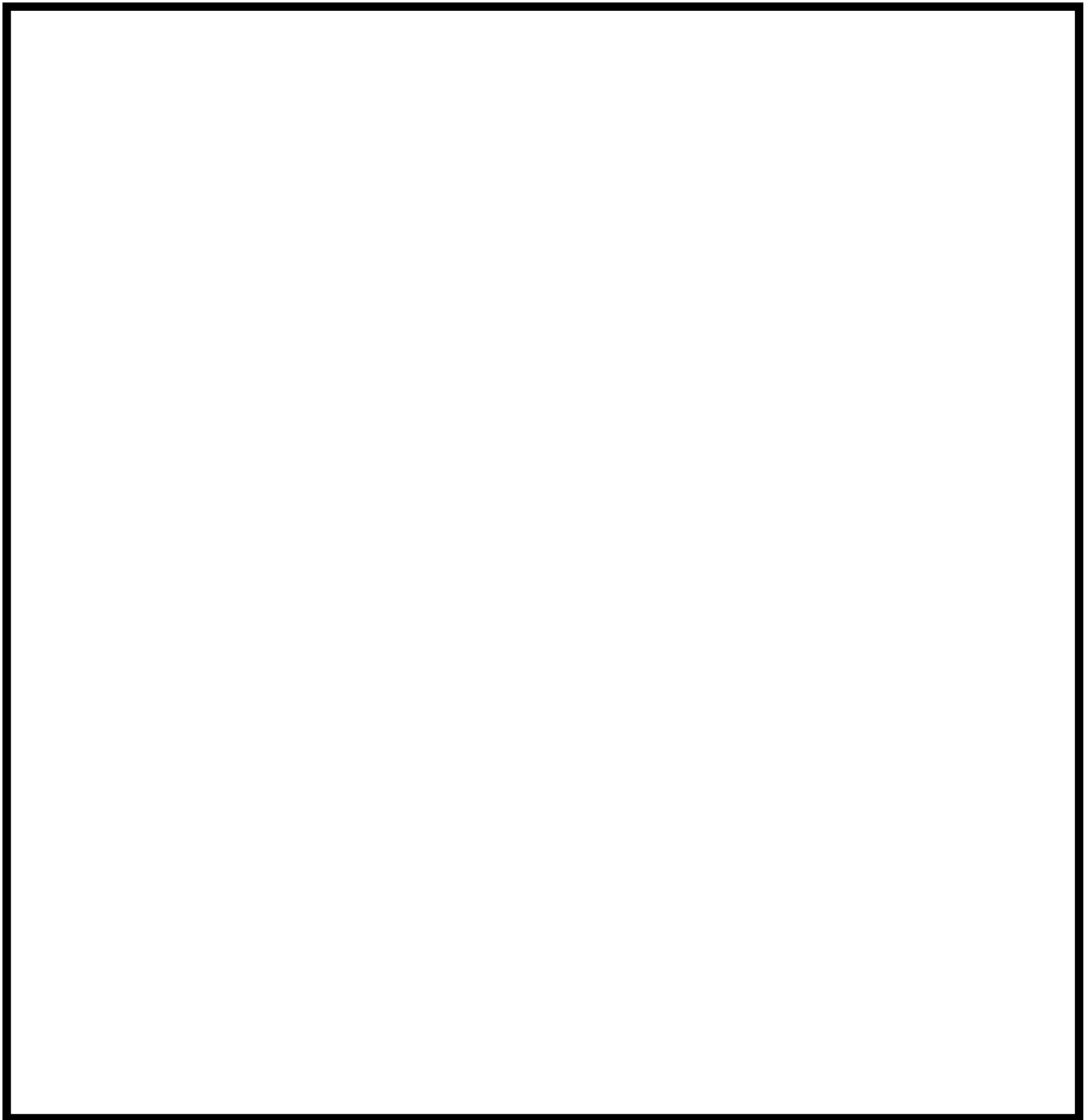
**Every home should have a family

Create Your Escape Plan

Draw a floor plan of your home and include doors and windows. Mark two ways out of each room in case of a fire. Talk about your home escape plan with your family and don't forget to discuss a safe meeting place outside of your home!

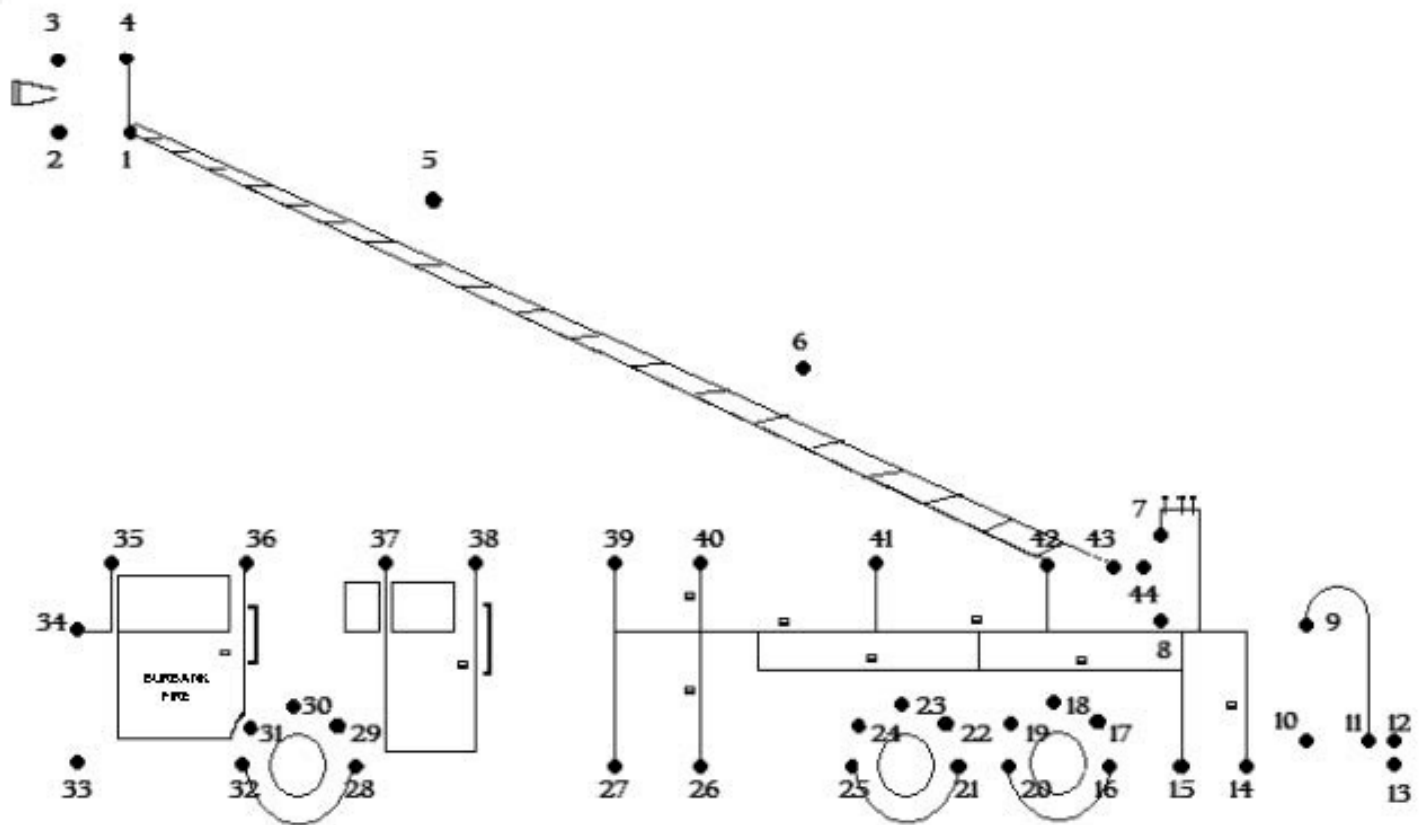

Connect the dots, starting from 1 and ending at 44, to see what appears! When you are done, you can color me in.

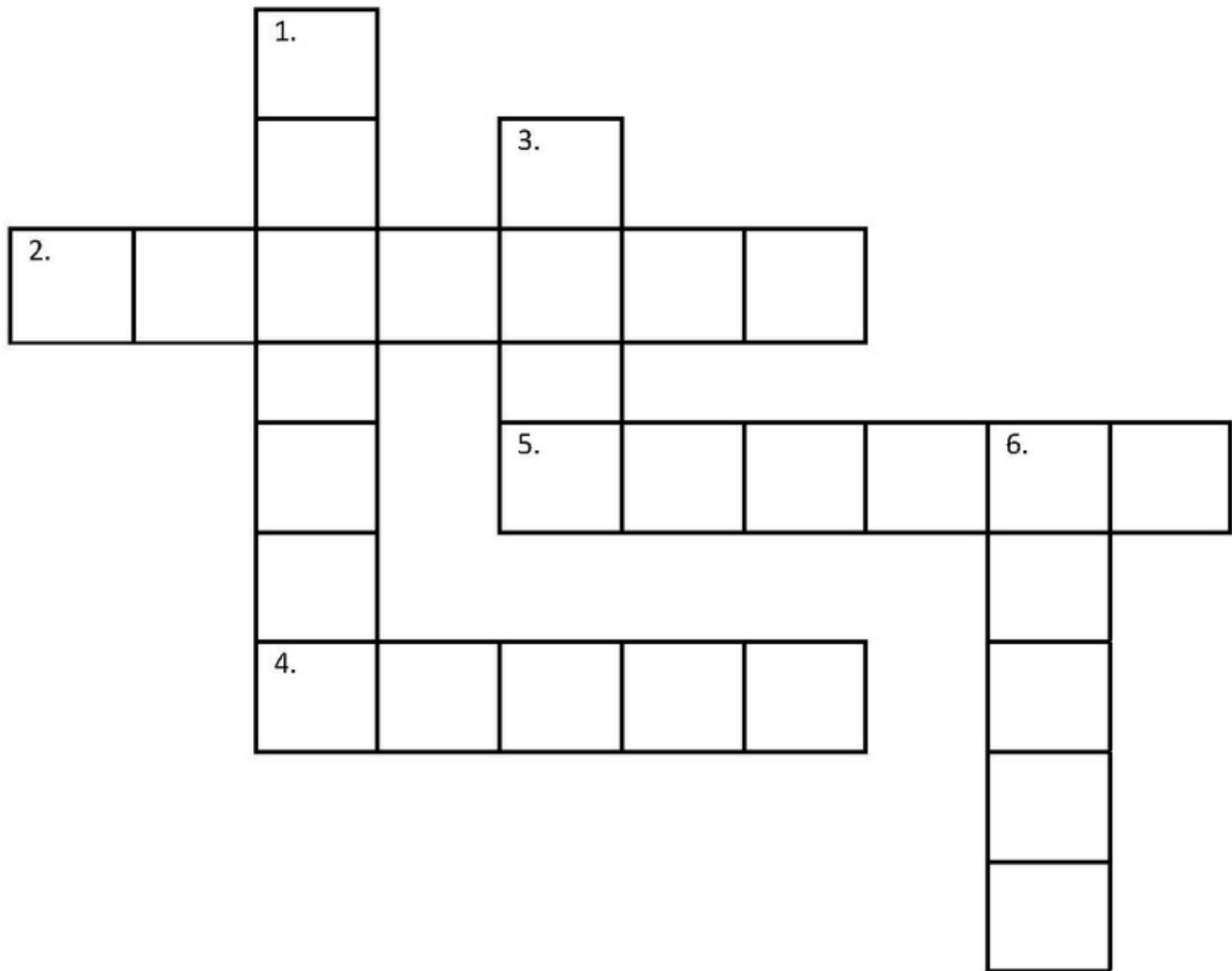


When a fire breaks out, crawl low under the smoke. The air is easier to breathe near the floor.
