REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS

Under current department policy, only contractors holding one of the following classifications are properly licensed to contract solely for the installation and/or removal of underground storage tanks in Burbank.

NOTE: Effective January 1, 1994, all contractors performing the installation or removal of an underground storage tank(s) must hold the Hazardous Waste Certification issued by the Contractors State License Board.
