- Present a photo ID
- Agree to adhere to the policies of the “SAFE”

PROHIBITED ITEMS INSIDE THE STORAGE CONTAINER

- Food
- Waste
- Weapons
- Recyclables
- Liquids/wet items
- Drugs/paraphernalia
- Pets (alive or deceased)
- Needles (unless disclosed and approved)
- Organic Material (anything living, including plants)
- Sharp objects (including all knives and sharp tools)
