The City of Burbank Parks and Recreation Department is recruiting for the Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program. The CIT program is a 10-week volunteer opportunity for high school students to gain valuable work experience, earn service hours, and enhance their resume and interview skills.

Components of the CIT program include:

- Daily interaction with City of Burbank staff and program participants in the Afterschool Daze Program.
- Hands-on experience working with children and leading various activities.
- Interactive training sessions that will explore activity planning and career opportunities.

If selected, requirements are as follows:

- CITs may not have more than 3 unexcused absences during the 10-week program.
- Must complete 3 activities, rate satisfactory or above on their final evaluation, and attend orientation and 3 training sessions.
- Students who do not complete all requirements will not receive a certificate of completion.
