Brief Project Description: Burbank 2035 is the City of Burbank's General Plan. Burbank's existing General Plan was adopted in the 1960s. Various elements of the General Plan have been updated and amended in the intervening years, but the plan has not been comprehensively revised since that time. Burbank 2035 describes the current vision of quality of life, priorities for resource protection, and manner of future growth within Burbank over the next 20+ years. The Greenhouse Gas Reduction Plan is an implementing action for Burbank 2035 describing measures intended to reduce greenhouse gas emissions within the community at-large and within City operations.

Determination: Based on a review of the project as proposed, the Department of Fish and Game has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish and Game Code [FGC] Section 711.4(c)) the project has no effect on fish, wildlife or their habitat and the project as described does not require payment of a CEQA filing fee.
