


CEQA

- The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires the City to conduct an environmental review process before the requested actions may be approved.
- CEQA Objectives:
 - Encourage informed decisions
 - Identify ways to minimize or avoid significant effects of a project
 - Increase the public's understanding of the review process
 - Enhance public participation in the review process
 - Promote coordination between government agencies
