LOCKER ROOM ATTENDANT

DEFINITION

Under supervision, to do simple pool and facility maintenance work; to monitor locker rooms; to work in a snack bar; and to do related work as required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Monitors maintenance supplies and cleans pool facility, including locker rooms, deck, office and pool area; picks up refuse and litter; sweeps and vacuums pool both in and out of water; monitors locker rooms and enforces rules and regulations; assists with swim meets and other special events; accepts money and dispenses prepackaged food in snack bar.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Employment Standards:

- Ability to - operate mechanical equipment used in a large swimming pool; understand and follow written and oral instructions; learn and understand pool facility maintenance operations; enforce locker room rules and regulations and maintain discipline; count money accurately; swim and perform assigned duties safely; establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, fellow employees, and the public.

License & Certificates: Valid Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), Communicable Disease, and First Aid Certificates from authorized providers, as determined by the Management Services department, within two weeks of appointment.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

A valid California Class "C" driver's license or equivalent may be required at time of appointment.
