

Betsy Lueke Creative Arts Center Pottery Classes

FEES: All clay and firing fees must be paid upon receipt. Cash, Check, Visa and Mastercard are accepted (\$7.00 minimum for check or credit card purchase). **NO CREDIT or I.O.U.**

Clay: \$10.00 for 25 lb. bag (B-Mix Grog, B-Mix Sand, Maya-Red, Porcelain, Soldate, & Dark Brown)
ONLY clay purchased at the Betsy Lueke Creative Arts Center may be fired in our kilns.

Firing Fees: 10 cents per square inch for bisque firing (includes glaze firings plus all glazes). All pieces are measured and priced by staff. All pieces must be paid for regardless of your satisfaction with your work. Refire Cost is ½ price.

Workshops: Students enrolled in the current session may come and work on their projects during workshop hours. Workshops are for independent work. No instruction is offered.

Workshop hours: Friday 9:00 a.m.–3:30 p.m.
Saturday 9:00 a.m.–12:45 p.m.

Cost: \$3.00 per workshop visit.

You must sign in and fee must be paid prior to entering workshop.

SPACE:

- Clay may not be stored at the Betsy Lueke Creative Arts Center.
- All pottery is stored at your own risk.
- Please pay for and remove your glazed pottery promptly. Take home bisqueware if not glazing promptly. Shelf space is limited.
- All pottery left behind from previous sessions will be disposed of at the end of the second week of the new session.

CLEAN-UP:

- Students must be cleaned up and out the door at the scheduled class end time.
- Clean all tools (rolling pins, brushes, pans, wheels and splash pans, extruder, etc.) and any surfaces (table, boards, glazing table, slab rollers, etc.) you have used during class. Leave the studio clean for the next class.
- Throw excess clay into the recycling containers next to the door or trash cans. **Clay clogs the plumbing!**

WHEEL WORK:

- There is no wheel instruction in the beginning classes.
- There are 9 wheels available.

STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Clay board (approximately 12"x14" of ½" plywood).
- Notebook
- Basic Pottery Tool kits are available for purchase in the office for \$10 .
