### **AIRPORT AUTHORITY VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO APPROVE “MOU” WITH SOUTH COAST AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AND AN AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

BURBANK, Calif., November 6, 2019 — On November 4, 2019, the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority Commission voted unanimously to approve a voluntary Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) and approved an Air Quality Improvement Plan (AQIP) to minimize and reduce air emissions related to non-aircraft mobile source activities at the Hollywood Burbank Airport, effective January 1, 2020.

Over the past year, SCAQMD staff held four working group meetings and developed a voluntary agreement with all commercial airports in the South Coast Basin (Burbank, Long Beach, Los Angeles, Ontario and John Wayne) giving direction to achieve emission reductions for non-aircraft airport sources. Airport staff worked with Trifiletti Consulting, Inc. and CDM Smith, and developed a comprehensive AQIP that represents a wholistic plan to reduce emissions from non-aircraft mobile sources related to airport operations.

The AQIP includes the following measures: a ground support equipment emissions reduction policy, a clean construction policy, an airport clean fleet policy, a zero-emission bus program, an electric vehicle charging infrastructure program, participation in the Burbank Transportation Management Organization, the continuation of the Burbank Metrolink Shuttle Program to reduce trips, and a program to promote sustainable design in construction projects.

Annual reports will be provided to SCAQMD identifying the status of achieving Measures goals, corrective measures if any, progress on initiatives, any changes or updates to Measures or Initiatives and any items that may not have been covered in the AQIP.
