LINE MECHANIC SUPERVISOR

DEFINITION

Under direction, to supervise a crew engaged in constructing, maintaining, and repairing overhead and underground electrical systems; and to do related work as required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Supervises, trains, and evaluates employees in the construction, maintenance, and repair of electrical transmission, distribution and street lighting systems, both overhead and underground; schedules and assigns crews; reads, interprets, and explains engineering drawings and specifications related to the performance of the work; supervises employees working on energized lines on poles and in vaults; assures needed material is available for jobs and prepares requisitions; maintains records; prepares written reports; trains personnel in proper safety procedures; locates and clears trouble in the electrical system; oversees the installation of underground duct lines, cables, and associated equipment; drives on City business.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Employment Standards:

- Knowledge of –The methods, materials, and equipment used in the lineman/splicer trade; the California Public Utilities Commission General Orders 95 and 128 concerning the construction and maintenance of overhead and underground transmission and distribution systems; electrical theory; fundamental safety regulations, first aid, and the methods of applying resuscitation
- Ability to - Think and act effectively in an emergency; effectively direct others toward a desired result; establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, fellow employees, and the public.

Education/Training: Three years recent journeyman level experience in the construction, maintenance, and repair of overhead or underground electrical systems, including two years of work on high voltage energized lines.

Special Conditions & Requirements: Employees in this classification will be required to comply with the American National Standards Institute's requirements on Practices for Respiratory Protection. COLOR VISION: Keen color perception. Must have the strength and physical agility to climb poles and work underground.

License & Certificates: A valid California Class "C" driver's license or equivalent at time of appointment.
